CALL TO ORDER OF THE SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

The special called meeting of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BMA) was called to order by Mayor Lee Davis at 4:45 PM. Mr. Jeff Drumm was the only citizen in attendance.

ROLL CALL

Town Administrator Mariah Prescott called the roll, noting the presence of Mayor Lee Davis, Vice Mayor Lizzy Schmidt, and Alderwoman Angela Cassidy. Town Attorney Sam Elliott was absent.

NEW BUSINESS

1. CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSED RESOLUTION 2026-657 OFFER TO AMEND THE REAL ESTATE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE TOTTEN PROPERTY ACQUISITION ORIGINALLY PASSED BY RESOLUTION 2026-645

Vice Mayor Lizzy Schmidt summarized the resolution, noting that it is to ensure that the contract for purchase of the Totten Property (TProp) doesn't expire. This resolution will extend the purchase and sale agreement through the November referendum.

Mayor Lee Davis noted that the petition circulated against the Town financing the TProp should be certified by the Hamilton County Election Commission on Wednesday, June 17. In closing, Mayor Davis stated that the new deadline for expiration of the purchase and sale agreement is 01/28/2027.

VICE MAYOR LIZZY SCHMIDT MOVED TO APPROVE RESOLUTION 2026-657, SECONDED BY ALDERWOMAN ANGELA CASSIDY AND UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN.

ADJOURNMENT

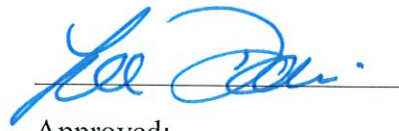
Mayor Lee Davis adjourned the meeting at 4:49 PM.
